I attach here A Statement of Solidarity and Concern about Nicaragua from Members of the Boston College Community. As the Director of the Jesuit Institute here at Boston College and knowing that many administrators, staff, faculty, alumni and students have visited and worked in Nicaragua I invited those here on campus this summer to consider signing the statement.

We have roughly 480 signatures. Among them are more than 180 faculty, 140 administrators and staff and 140 alumni and students and among all of them are 37 Jesuits at BC.

We ask that you bring our concern for the people of Nicaragua to the attention of your fellow members of Congress so that peace and justice may return to Nicaragua.
